# TREASURER'S REPORT 2024

With 2024 closing, it is my pleasure to report we have completed the relevant auditing requirements, our accounts are in order for the relevant authorities and confirm our management of the club is in order from a financial standpoint.

A thank you to Andrew North for his continued auditing assistance for the club.

2024 was again a successful year, with favourable end of year position, profit and surplus wise. This is another strong outcome which enables us to reinvest in the club through facilities and member benefits. It is worth highlighting some considerable examples of this in 2024 – the Ron Payne canteen; Net-Set-Go free registration and apparel to drive participation; investment in accreditation of our coaches; installation of defibrillators at both Ron Payne and North Epping Oval; as well as investment in holding our Rangers component of membership fees whilst other relevant association costs increased.

Enabling benefits for our members is paramount and a key reason why we can do this is due to another season of very strong support from our sponsors. Our sponsors play a critical role and for their ongoing support of the community and NERSC, we thank them.

Our 2024 season saw a continued drive on Rangers merchandise and branding which was supported with sales through the canteen and through our newly launched online store created within our website.

As each season begins and each season closes, I would like to pass on a massive and well deserved thank you to the Convenors, the Football, Netball and Tennis Committees and the North Epping Rangers Sports Club Management Committee for the diligence and effectiveness this year, which allows us to have strong foundations as we head into 2025.

# TENNIS REPORT 2024

NER expanded to include a tennis section at the 2023 AGM.

NER Tennis manages the courts and bookings at both North Epping Oval (NEO), and the bookings at North Epping Bowling and Community Club (NEBCC) courts, known as the North Epping Sports Centre (NESC).

We are currently affiliated with Tennis NSW as the governing body of the sport in NSW. Affiliation is for the July-June financial year with the main benefit currently being insurance. Tennis NSW provide support and offer other benefits to its affiliated clubs.

The tennis section has been spent the year reviewing the existing NER Tennis environment with a view to creating a “plan for the future”. Social tennis has been a good income source for the club and we are looking to expand on this. Tennis membership, formal coaching, and tennis events are all being considered.

A new gate access system at NEO is being installed that will integrate with the booking system, providing better access and security for the courts and our members. This has been made possible by a Bendigo Bank grant.

NER Tennis has the opportunity to deliver special events, gala days, and social activities throughout the year, to bring the community together and create connection in addition to the current NER offerings.

## **NetSetGo**
