Our Governing Bodies acknowledge that staff, members, and volunteers provide a valuable contribution to the experiences of Children and Adults at Risk involved in sport. The Governing Bodies aim to continue this and to take measures to protect the safety and wellbeing of all Children and Adults at Risk participating in sport.
